Professor Tomohito Kameda Recognized Among the World's Top 2% Scientists in Environmental Science (2025 Update)

Professor Tomohito Kameda has once again been recognized as one of the world's top 2% scientists in Environmental Science, according to the August 2025 update of the "Updated Science-Wide Author Databases of Standardized Citation Indicators." Curated by John P.A. Ioannidis and collaborators, this globally recognized database ranks researchers based on standardized citation metrics, including h-index, co-authorship—adjusted hm-index, and a composite score (c-score).

The August 1, 2025 Scopus data update evaluates the career-long contributions (citations up to the end of 2024). The selection encompasses the top 100,000 scientists (or those within the top 2% of their subfields) across 22 scientific fields and 174 subfields.
